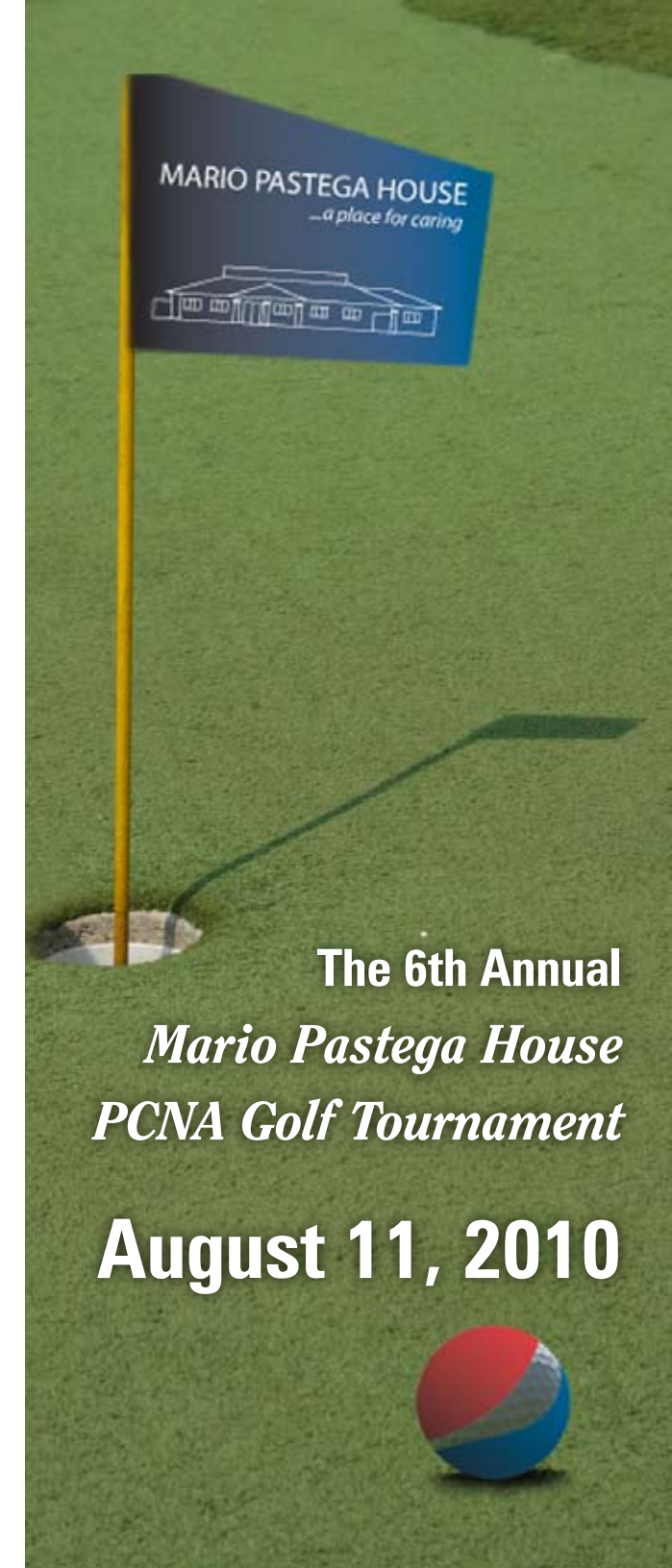

The Mario Pastega House opened in September 2004 to provide inexpensive, comfortable lodging and a caring environment for Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center patients and family members from outside the Corvallis area. The house functions as a tranquil, healing retreat during times of medical crisis.

The Pastega House was the vision of local businessman Mario Pastega, who believed that supportive, nurturing and affordable lodging facilities were vital to the thousands of out-of-area families seeking lifesaving medical treatment. The project was started with a significant personal gift from Pastega, who led a \$2.3 million fund drive to make the house a reality.

Since opening the Pastega House has:

- Provided over 20,000 nights of lodging for patients and families
- Served almost 30,000 individual guests
- Had an average room occupancy rate of 83.2%
- Provided lodging for a nominal fee of \$20 per night
- Never turned anyone away due to inability to pay

Golf with Bob Gilder...



Prior to tee-off, PGA professional Bob Gilder will be on the auction block, joining the team with the winning bid for 18 holes of tournament golf. Mr. Gilder's score will be included as part of his team's overall score.

Mr. Gilder will also host a pre-tournament golf clinic, beginning at 7:30 a.m. The clinic is open to all tournament participants and offers the opportunity to learn from the best, as Mr. Gilder offers tips and advice for improving golf scores.

Mr. Gilder has won six tournaments in his PGA Tour career and currently plays on the Champions Tour where he has nine wins. His successes include winning six tournaments between 1976 and 1983, including three in 1982, playing on the 1983 Ryder Cup team under captain Jack Nicklaus, winning two tournaments and being named 2001 Rookie of the Year in the Champions Tour and being a 2002 inductee into the Oregon Sports Hall of Fame.

Gilder is a life-long resident of Corvallis. He and his wife Peggy have a grandson with cystic fibrosis and are involved with several charities that help battle the disease, including Doernbecher Children's Hospital and the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation.
