Meet Marjorie Hutchins

Please say hi to Marjorie Hutchins, who joined us in the Wiley Creek Lodge in March! Before moving in, she had lived in the Cottages since we opened in 1998.

Marjorie was born Dec. 14, 1915, in Blachly, Ore., to Edwin and Tilly Robertson. She had two older brothers and a younger sister.

Her father, Edwin, was a custodian at the Triangle Lake Schools — including the country school she attended. Sadly, her mother died when Marjorie was 11. However, her dad was an excellent cook, and he taught her about cooking and homemaking.

Marjorie loved school, her friends and her community. She loved to dance; her family's main entertainment was going to dances nearly every Saturday at the grange hall.



She met Paul Hutchins through his two sisters, whom she knew from school. They were married in July 1936 after graduating from high school, and she went to work keeping house for a teacher.

She and Paul moved to Sweet Home in 1941, where Paul had a logging company. He later branched into construction, and he built roads throughout the Willamette Valley and in every corner of the state. During the summer, the family lived around

the state, wherever he was building a road. Marjorie did the bookkeeping for the business as well as take care of the family at home.

The couple had three children: Larry, in Sweet Home; Darlene, who has passed away; and Marilyn, in Sweet Home. The family loved hunting and fishing throughout Oregon, and they did extensive traveling with other relatives. Their road trips took them all over the country, from Alaska to Key West, Fla.

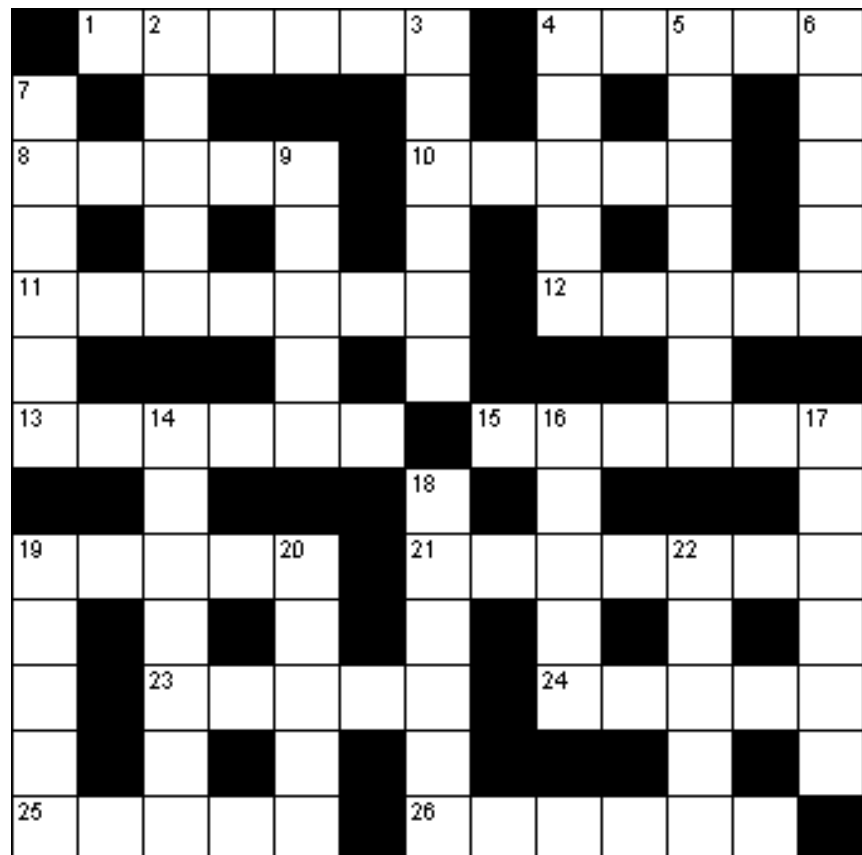

Sleep apnea

Whether we want to admit it or not, we all snore at times. But when does this snoring become a health issue?

If you're drowsy during the day and snoring every night, you may have a condition called sleep apnea, which can lead to some serious health problems. Sleep apnea is when you stop breathing briefly, multiple times each night — up to 30 an hour as you sleep.

Symptoms of sleep apnea are choking or gasping at night, waking up with a headache, anxiety, difficulty concentrating and irritability. If these symptoms keep occurring, they can lead to heart rhythm issues, high blood pressure, heart attack or stroke, as well as daytime accidents due to poor concentration.

Mild sleep apnea can be treated with lifestyle changes such as losing weight, avoiding alcohol, tobacco and sleeping pills, or sleeping on your side rather than back or stomach. A special machine is available if you have a serious case.

So if you have the symptoms of sleep apnea, see your health care provider and discuss possible treatments.
