- Pre-clinical Education
 - Please refer to the attached Verification Form for instructions regarding the attachments and a complete listing of information that must be completed prior to clinical rotations.
 - This process must be completed prior to your arrival to facilitate a smooth transition to clinical practice. Failure to do so will delay the start of your clinical rotations.
- Drug screen
 - **The testing must be done no sooner than Wednesday, June 20 and no later than Friday, June 22.**
 - Follow the enclosed “Drug Testing Protocol and Procedure” to schedule your screening and ensure a proper sample.
- Orientation to Samaritan Health Services
 - **June 25, 2007 0800-1615** This orientation, designed to introduce you to Samaritan Health Services, will be located in Hewlett-Packard and Starker conference rooms, 1st floor, Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center, Corvallis, Oregon.
 - **June 26, 2007 0700-0800** A welcome breakfast at your local hospital campus (the hospital closet to your first clinical rotation site) is scheduled that will allow you to meet with the Administrative team and your first physician preceptor.

Samaritan Health Services Drug Testing Protocol and Procedure

General Information:

- A urine drug testing must be completed BEFORE student begins his/her rotations within Samaritan Health Services.
- The student may not have his/her urine drug screen collected any earlier than **5 days** prior to the beginning of rotations.
- The cost of the screen is \$34.75 (cash or credit card only). Additional charges will apply if the screen is not negative.

- Do not drink more than 16 ounces (2 cups) of liquid, 4 hours prior to your schedule appointment time.
- Be prepared to produce a urine specimen when you arrive at Samaritan Occupational Medicine.
- Bring a picture I.D. (e.g. Driver's License) with you.
