

**More information about a recent letter you received from Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) about a change to your copayments**

Dear InterCommunity Health Network Member,

You have recently received a letter from the Department of Human Services (DHS) Division of Medical Assistance Programs (DMAP) discussing a change to your Oregon Health Plan (OHP) co-payments. In that letter, DMAP states that you may have to pay copayments for some of your medical services starting January 1, 2011.

As your health plan, InterCommunity Health Network (IHN) has decided **NOT** to require its members to make co-payments for medical services.

You can continue to receive medical services from your providers with no co-payments. IHN will not be asking our members to pay co-payments.
