All patients, visitors and staff are:



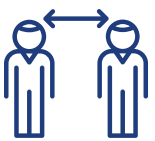
Screened for coronavirus symptoms, including cough and fever.



Asked to practice careful hand hygiene and infection prevention, including washing or sanitizing hands often and covering coughs and sneezes.



Asked to bring their own face covering as wearing one will be required. A mask will be provided to those who do not have one.



Asked to practice physical distancing, standing or sitting at least six feet apart whenever possible and to observe one-way traffic flows where indicated.

In our facilities:



Visitor restrictions limit the number of people in our buildings.



Essential staff only are working in our facilities; others are working from home.



Hand sanitation stations can be found throughout our facilities.



Continuous cleaning happens in all areas, and high-touch surfaces are cleaned frequently.



Personal protective equipment such as face masks, gloves and gowns are used in strict accordance with health guidelines.
