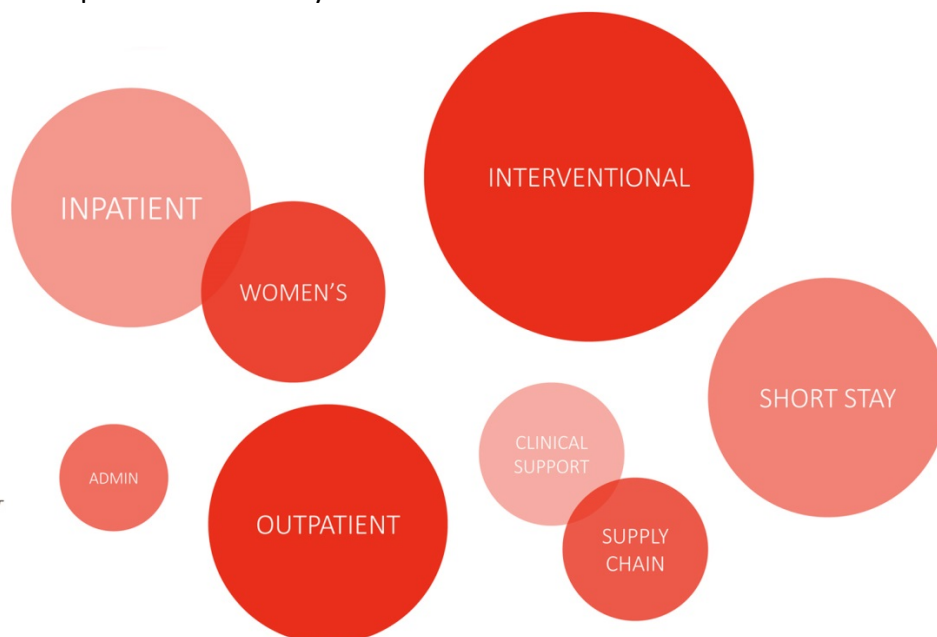
QUICK LOOK AT OUR PROGRESS

- We are moving ahead with plans to obtain low-cost financing by selling revenue bonds. This Friday, SNLH CEO Dr. Lesley Ogden and other SHS administrators will meet again with staff from the Oregon Facilities Authority.
- Business Analytics meetings are on track to start next week and individual interviews are currently underway.
- We are awaiting a final report on the geotechnical studies that were done on our hospital property. This will help pinpoint the best site on our 12-acre campus to build an earthquake-resistant facility.
- As for the large-scale planning/pre-design work, the Big Questions group has wrapped up its meetings, and the Patient Experience and Community Engagement groups are still at work.

OPERATIONAL TRANSFORMATION

The next step is Operational Transformation, and we'll be talking about that a lot in coming weeks. The transformation process investigates our workflow and organizational process here at SNLH, and this information will guide the design of our new hospital. We will be transforming ourselves, inside and out!

Eight groups will begin meeting on Oct. 26 to discuss ways to fundamentally transform the way we deliver our services. They will encompass every department at SNLH, from administration to volunteer services and everything in between. Every department will fall into one of the platform bubbles pictured here.
