Temporary road closure Oct. 22

There will be a temporary road closure of just a few hours on Monday, Oct. 22, on 28th Street, east of the senior living center delivery driveway. The reason? Crews will be trenching across the roadway to install electrical power to the project site. Two great things about this: the underground power line will provide commercial/industrial strength 480-volt service to the construction site and, ultimately, to our new hospital. This means plenty of energy efficient power to run medical equipment, lights and more in our new building!

Foundation work continues

Concrete continues to be poured for our massive foundation. Not much to add about that, really, except that it's progressing on schedule thanks to our recent lovely autumn weather and hard-working crews.

Floor plan

While many managers and staff have seen the final floor plan of our new building, many more have not. So, here it is for your viewing pleasure! The type may be too tiny to read, so here is some assistance—Top of the image is north, directly under our helipad. Right faces Devils Lake. Bottom is 28th Street, which leaves the left side facing west and nearly touching our existing hospital. The arrows point to the three entrances (emergency at top, main in middle and employee at bottom).

Color coding defines the areas, too. The main areas are: Emergency Department and Lab at top. Inpatient rooms at right. Labor and Delivery at bottom right. Surgical Services at bottom. Materials Management and Environmental Services at bottom left. Kitchen and Cafeteria at left. Pharmacy and Imaging in center.
