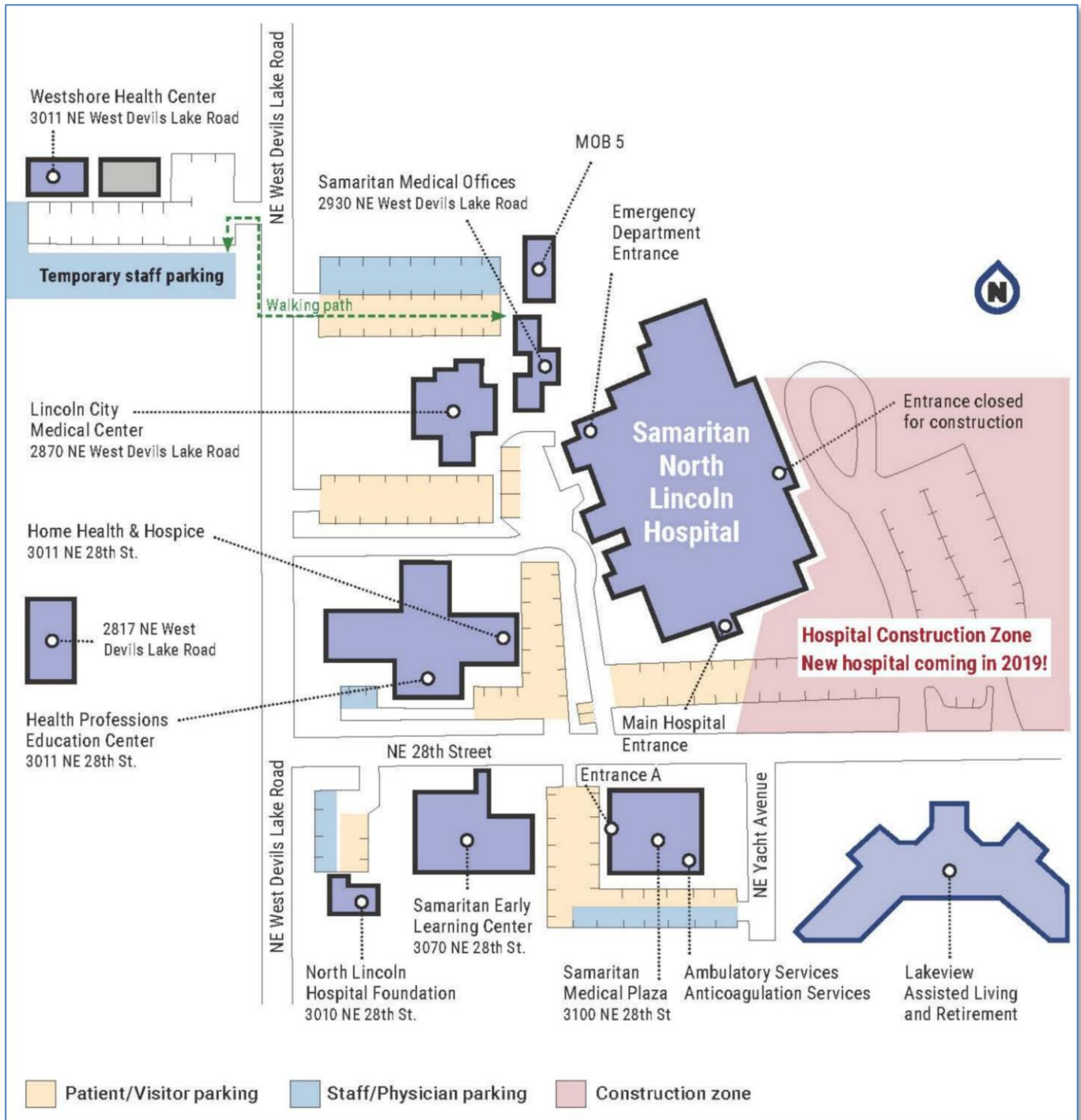

Counting down to mid-June construction start

Construction mode for the new Samaritan North Lincoln Hospital will switch to full speed ahead beginning around June 18. That's the anticipated date for construction fencing to be placed around the perimeter of the construction site so that heavy equipment operators can get to work.

Once this happens, the main entrance to the hospital will be closed, except for emergency exit and access to the medical helipad, which will remain operational throughout the 18- to 24-month construction time-frame. Wayfinding signage will be posted inside the hospital and on the campus to help patients, visitors and staff find their way to the hospital's temporary main entrance and parking areas. Volunteers will staff information desks, prepared with updated campus and hospital maps to share.

The temporary staff parking area is being laid out now at the Westshore Health Center, just 250 yards northwest of the main hospital building. Changes to the campus during construction will undoubtedly create some discomfort and CEO Dr. Lesley Ogden asks for everyone's patience and understanding. After all, the end result will be so worth it!
