PROJECT UPDATE: Sept. 28, 2016

MEET THE ARCHITECT & DESIGNER

At the Quality Fair held Tuesday at our hospital, many Samaritan employees as well as members of the public had the opportunity to meet with architect **Frank Cedarblade**, vice president of HGA Architects and Engineers, and designer **Michelle Chavez**. HGA is partnering with the construction firm Skanska and the financial planning firm WIPFLi to plan, design and build our new hospital campus. Cedarblade tells us that the top three questions (and answers) asked throughout the day were:



1. **When will the hospital be built?** Construction should begin in 2017 and doors should open on the new building(s) and redesigned medical campus sometime in 2019.
2. **Where will it be located?** Somewhere on the 12-acre property except where the current hospital is located, since our doors must remain open and we must continue to provide medical care to our community without interruption.
3. **Is there an architectural drawing of the new hospital?** No, not yet. Design work will begin in late February 2017, after all predesign planning, research and other necessary footwork are completed.
