## **NEW SAMARITAN HOSPITAL COMING TO NEWPORT**

### **FOCUS ON FOUNDATION**

This week, dirt was moved into a 30-foot hill as massive rollers compacted what remained. By Friday, project managers hope the building pad will be ready for foundation preparation to begin. Over the next month or so, watch for crews to cut into the compacted pad to build foundation footings and to add underground plumbing and electrical before the concrete gets poured.

### **WORK NOW SEPARATE FROM CURRENT HOSPITAL**

After part of the Outpatient Treatment Center was removed this week, the current hospital is now separated from the construction. All work now will be on the outside.

### **WHAT LIES BENEATH?**

There's been nothing of archeological significance discovered on the construction site as crews have moved more than 20,000 cubic yards of dirt. However, a small collection is growing out in the construction trailer as objects are unearthed (see photo below).
