



Our Samaritan Pacific Communities Hospital project is entering its third and final phase. Please note these important dates and share with others as appropriate:

BEGINNING MONDAY, MARCH 9

The 1951 building will be closed to all visitors and patients. The public can continue to access the hospital via the west entrance, which connects to the SPCH Galleria, until March 30. The Emergency Services entrance also continues to provide public access to the hospital.

WEEK OF MONDAY, MARCH 9

Remodeling will begin on the area behind the clinic located on the second floor of the new hospital building (the temporary infusion area). There may be a bit of construction noise and foot traffic during this time, and the north half of the employee break room will be temporarily blocked off. This is expected to last approximately 90 days.

BEGINNING MONDAY, MARCH 16

Construction fences will go around the perimeter of the 1951 building. The building will be permanently closed to everyone except crews that will begin clearing out the structure and performing abatement. Again, the west entrance to the Galleria will remain open until March 30.

WEEK OF MARCH 30

Demolition of the 1951 building will begin and the west entrance will be closed to everyone.

LATE SUMMER

Once the 1951 building is removed, the second half of the main parking area will be completed, essentially marking the end of this years'-long project.

EARLY AUTUMN

Watch for announcements about a community celebration being planned.
