

Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center Nursing Excellence Scholarship

Background -- The Nursing Excellence Scholarship was established in 2013 in honor/memory of outstanding Registered Nurses (RN) at Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center (GSRMC).

Purpose -- The Nursing Excellence Scholarship provides scholarships to nursing students working towards an RN, BSN or MSN degree who show leadership and clinical expertise and excellence.

Award – A minimum of one scholarship is given annually. Awards for each student are a minimum of \$500.

Uses – Scholarships are used for tuition, books, and school fees.

Eligibility -- Candidate must:

- Be enrolled or enrolling in the final year an accredited nursing program
- Be in good academic standing
- Current GSRMC employee (preferred)
- RN, BSN or MSN program (preferred)

Application Process and Timeline:

- Application information is available to college financial aid/career planning staff, as well as on the Samaritan Health Services website.
- Completed applications are due March 15 each year. Scholarship recipient(s) will be announced at the end of April.
- Scholarship funds in the recipient's name will be mailed directly to the college/university indicated on the application. No funds will be released directly to the recipient.
