

Virginia Welch Scholarship

Each year the Good Samaritan Regional Medical Center Auxiliary awards the Virginia Welch Scholarship to students planning to pursue a career in a medically related field. The scholarship is named in honor of Virginia Welch, a head nurse who became Good Samaritan's administrator in 1951 and served until 1967. Since 1997, more than \$250,000 has been awarded to students pursuing a career in health care.

Eligibility

High school seniors, undergraduate and graduate students currently enrolled in, or accepted to, a program to pursue a career in a health or medically related field in a hospital setting are eligible to apply.

Application process

Application deadline: April 10, 2020

To apply for the Virginia Welch Scholarship, please complete and print the application packet in its entirety below. Applications must be received or postmarked by April 10, 2020. It is the responsibility of the applicant to submit a complete application on time. Late applications will not be considered.
