PRIDE Partner - Program support

Beneficiary: Businesses can designate their support to programs and hospitals they care about by making a PRIDE investment and aligning with Samaritan's vision of serving our communities with Passion, Respect, Integrity, Dedication and Excellence.

ArtsCare (all communities)

Art and music are incorporated in the health-care setting to enhance the healing environment. Examples of ArtsCare projects at Samaritan include certified harp practitioners who perform for patients and know how to match their tempo with patients' breathing and art instructors who help patients undergoing dialysis express their creativity through art projects. Special ArtsCare programming for youth is available, through donor support, at Samaritan Pediatrics and Samaritan Mental Health in the Brauti Wellness Center located at the Boys & Girls Club of Corvallis Johnson Teen Center. More than 35,000 people experience the benefit of ArtsCare annually.

Employee Emergency Fund (all communities)

Samaritan employs 5,000 people in five communities. We want our employees to display their PRIDE values every day. To support individuals and their families, we have established an Employee Emergency Fund where staff can apply for financial support during crisis and emergencies. Funds are distributed in the form of payment towards vendor bills (rent, utilities, etc.).

Patient Support (all communities)

Patient support funds are available for patients in Linn, Lincoln, and Benton counties who are low-income and who are receiving treatment for an illness or chronic disease or are in the process of being discharged from a hospital stay or emergency room visit. The program also assists hospice patients. Our goal is to help reduce the barriers that stand in the way of their recovery, wellness and comfort. Currently, 1,000 patients across the system are receiving patient support services.

Samaritan Treatment & Recovery Services (all communities; administered through Lebanon Hospital Foundation)

Oregon ranks fourth in the United States for substance use disorders, and 50th for access to services. With the communities' tremendous support, Samaritan is helping meet this need with the new Samaritan Treatment and Recovery Services (STARS) facility in Lebanon which opened in summer 2020. PRIDE Partnership funds will support program implementation and support services such as assessments, groups, and referrals for mental health needs.

SamCare Mobile Medicine (all communities, administered through Good Samaritan Hospital)

Despite gains in the number of people covered by insurance and the expansion of medical services that Samaritan has brought to the mid-Willamette Valley and central Oregon Coast, too many people still struggle to access basic care. SamCare Mobile Medicine brings basic health care services to schools and community locations. These services include: well child checkups, sports physicals, vaccinations, community health screenings and work site health and wellness.

Hospice (all communities, Hospice House located in Albany)

Samaritan Evergreen Hospice serves patients in the familiar surroundings of their own homes, skilled nursing facility, adult foster home and assisted living facilities. While most hospice care is provided in a patient's home, there are times when a patient needs to come to an inpatient facility for acute symptom management. The Samaritan Evergreen Hospice House serves this purpose.

Sarah's Place (all communities, administered and located in Albany)

Sarah's Place provides victim-centered care, sensitive to the needs of survivors of sexual assault. Located in Albany, it is the first Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) program in Oregon where sexual assault nurse examiners are available 24/7 to provide medical care in a discreet environment separate from the emergency department. Sarah's Place staff also directs their efforts and resources at prevention in the community to reduce sexual violence.

Samaritan Emergency Relief Fund (all communities, administered through Good Samaritan Hospital Foundation)

The Samaritan Emergency Relief Fund was established to help Samaritan Health Services respond to emergent needs related to extreme emergencies, such as COVID-19. The fund will provide relief and support patients throughout the region at all five Samaritan affiliated hospitals.

Furniture, fixtures and equipment (all communities)

Samaritan Health Services is committed to providing top-quality and state-of-the-art care. There will always be a need to replace and upgrade equipment, as technology leads us to innovate in new ways. Our hospitals budget for equipment replacement and capital expenditures, however there often are unanticipated needs when equipment wears out before its expected life-span.

Reach Out & Read (Albany, Corvallis and Lebanon)

Samaritan is proud to offer the Reach Out & Read program through funding from our local foundations. This program enables medical providers to give books to children at more than 10 well-child visits from infancy through age five. The providers also encourage families to read aloud and engage with their infants, toddlers and preschoolers every day. Funding is used to purchase books and approximately 4,000 books are distributed per community each year.
